All FFA members are required to turn in a **Record Book Form** instead of turning in a Colorado FFA Record Book. The Weld County Jr. Livestock Sale Committee is requiring this form to be turned in the same time as 4-H Record Books are due, hoping to prevent FFA members receiving letters after the sale stating that their record book was not turned in and that they are not eligible to sell in the following year's sale. Also, a Weld County Fair Rule states you must turn in this form eligible to show at the next year's Weld County Fair. If this form is not turned in by Friday after Labor Day you will be ineligible to show. This is a firm rule put in place by the Weld County Fair Board and cannot be waived.
