SHOWMEN: Disabled kids

MENTORS: 4-H members (12 and older)

JUDGES:

a. Use round Robin Judges

b. Use 4-H parents or announcers to just supervise the showing and act as judges

HOW THE SHOW WILL GO:

Kids will show up 1-2 hours before they show, the kids will meet their mentor and their animal. The mentors will help the kids wash and get their animal ready to show while round robin is happening. The kids will show right after round robin. Calf showmen will show in the cattle showpen. Hog showmen will show in the origanal hog showpen that was used on Saturday. Goats will show in the pen that was for goats during round robin. The horses will show where they showed for round robin.

HOW WILL THEY SHOW:

Horses - Walk the horse with mentor to the judge stop answer two questions from the judge. Walk the horse back to start.

Calf - Walk the calf to the judge, stop at judge. Judge asks kid two questions. Walk calf back to start.

Pig - Mentor walks with the kid with the pig a circle around the ring and go back to their holding pen. The judge comes up to the kid in the pen and asks them a couple questions about the pig.

Goats - The kid will walk their goat out into the ring and to the judge. The kid will stop in front of the judge and judge will ask two questions to the kid and the kid will walk back.

Every disabled participant will receive a bucket prize with fun prizes inside.

HOW TO ENTER:

Disabled kids will sign up six weeks before with our sign up genius. The mentor will sign up a month before fair, the program will count as a community service project.

SIDE NOTE

LIFE will handle all of the financial and entry portions of the event really we just need to know we get the time for the kids to show on that Sunday of fair.

Livestock will be donated by breeders. The animals will be trailered in on that Sunday. Mentors will have a meeting at seven thirty or eight to go over how the day will go for the show.
